



**Lochwinnoch Arts Festival 2019 Art Exhibition
Information for Exhibitors**

**Wednesday 13th March to Saturday 23rd March 2019
in the Library Room, Lochwinnoch Library.**

**Handing in day - Saturday 9th March
between 10am and 11am**

You may submit 2 framed original works.

Each work should be ready to hang and the hooks/d-rings on the back of each work should be covered with tape to prevent damage to other pieces. Only work framed in wooden frames will be accepted. No plastic frames or clip frames are allowed.

A label should be stuck to the back of the painting detailing the artist's name and address, the title of the painting, and the price.

A separate label with the title of the painting and the price should be tied on to hang down below the painting.

Your entry form should be submitted by 28th February by post to:-

All exhibits should be for sale with the price clearly marked.

This year we are taking a commission of 20% for Motor Neurone Disease.

A hanging fee of £1 per exhibit is to be paid on submission of work on the day.

You may also submit unframed prints of your work. Each unframed print must be cellophane wrapped and a label attached with details and price. Prints will be displayed in a browser. Unframed prints must be clearly marked that they are prints. Cellophane wrap can be obtained from most florists. Please provide a list of titles and prices.

You are responsible for insurance of any work you choose to have in the Library Room for the duration of the exhibition. The Library and the Arts Festival Committee will not be held responsible for any damage or theft whilst the exhibition is on their premises.

All unsold exhibits must be **collected between 2pm and 3.30pm on Saturday 23rd March**. These times must be adhered to and if you are unable to attend please arrange for someone to collect on your behalf as we are unable to store any exhibits.

All artists are invited to the Preview Evening on Wednesday 13th March at 7pm.
